F.M. Atterhold
Sumner Nash
J. Hugill
Hugo Schumacher
F.A. Wilcox

The purpose of forming the Board was to collect and record such local and general statistical information related to manufacturers and commerce as they promote the manufacturing, commercial and financial welfare of the City of Akron and especially to protect, foster and develop the manufacturing and other industrial interests of the City.

Some 40 years later, "The Board of Trade of Akron" would grow geographically to include Boards in the North, South and East Akron areas.

Later came the Kenmore, Southeast and West Boards. Each Board joined together to promote free enterprise and the general welfare of their local geographic area of the City.
