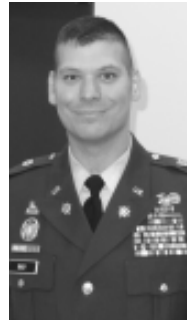
The Christmas In September - Support Our Troops Program . . .

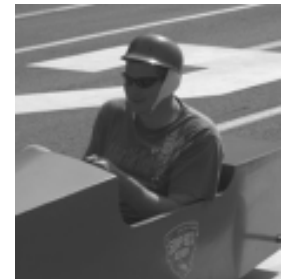
